Wirfs, of Kelkheim am Taunus, Hessen, Germany, was elected president of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 92nd International Convention, held in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA, July 6-10, 2009. Lions Clubs International is the world's largest service club organization and the global leader in humanitarian and community service.

President Wirfs, an entrepreneur and retired CEO of his own company, is a pioneer in the marketing of frozen food specialties across Europe.

Using as his presidential theme Move to Grow, President Wirfs plans to build momentum or movement and "grow" association membership in order to meet the increasing needs for community service around the world.

President Wirfs is an experienced and effective leader with particular strength in membership development and extension and leadership training, and in combining service and fellowship.

A member of the Hofheim am Taunus Lions Club since 1985, President Wirfs has held many offices within the association, including club president; district governor; council chairperson; faculty group leader for the District Governors-elect Seminar, which trains incoming governors; and international director. He served as CEO of the German Lions Foundation, Deutsches Hilfswerk. In addition, he systematically implemented Lions Quest, a mentoring program for young people, in Germany. He is an honorary member of the Kelkheim am Taunus Lions Club.

In recognition of his service to the association, President Wirfs has received numerous awards, including the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the association bestows upon its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

Qualifications for 100% President's Award

This is the only award a President can win. Download the application form from www.a3lions.org or ask the Zone Chair for a form. In May the Secretary of the club will send the form to the Zone or Region Chair for approval, who will then forward it to the District Governor for approval.

- A. The club shall have no unpaid balance of over US\$50.00 owing to Lions Clubs International as of March 31 of the fiscal year.
- B. The club must show a net increase in membership for the fiscal year.
- C. An accounting must be made for all Membership and Activity reports.
- D. From the following requirements, six must be completed:
 - 1. All other reports required by the international office and/or the District, or Multiple District must have been filed on time.
 - 2. The President must have personally sponsored one or more new members who shall have been inducted prior to June 30 of the fiscal year.
 - 3. The club must conduct at least one major fund-raising project, with substantial membership participation which must have been reported on the club's M&A report.
 - 4. The PU101 forms must have been submitted to the International office before May 30.
 - 5. The club must have completed at least one major service activity which must have been reported on the club's M&A report.
 - 6. The President must have attended at least two Zone Advisory meetings in person, and have attended or been represented at all other such meetings held in the Zone.
 - 7. The President must have attended a District or a Multiple District convention or conference, or International Convention, preceding or during the term of office.
 - 8. The President must have attended a club officer training school or session conducted by the District.

Qualifications for 100% Secretary Award

Download the appropriate application form from www.a3lions.org or ask the Zone Chair for a form. In order for the club Secretary to receive this award, the form must be completed, signed by the appropriate people and sent on to the District Governor by May 15 of the Lions Year. The Governor upon approval of this application will send the 100% Lions Secretary Award to the incoming Club President for presentation.

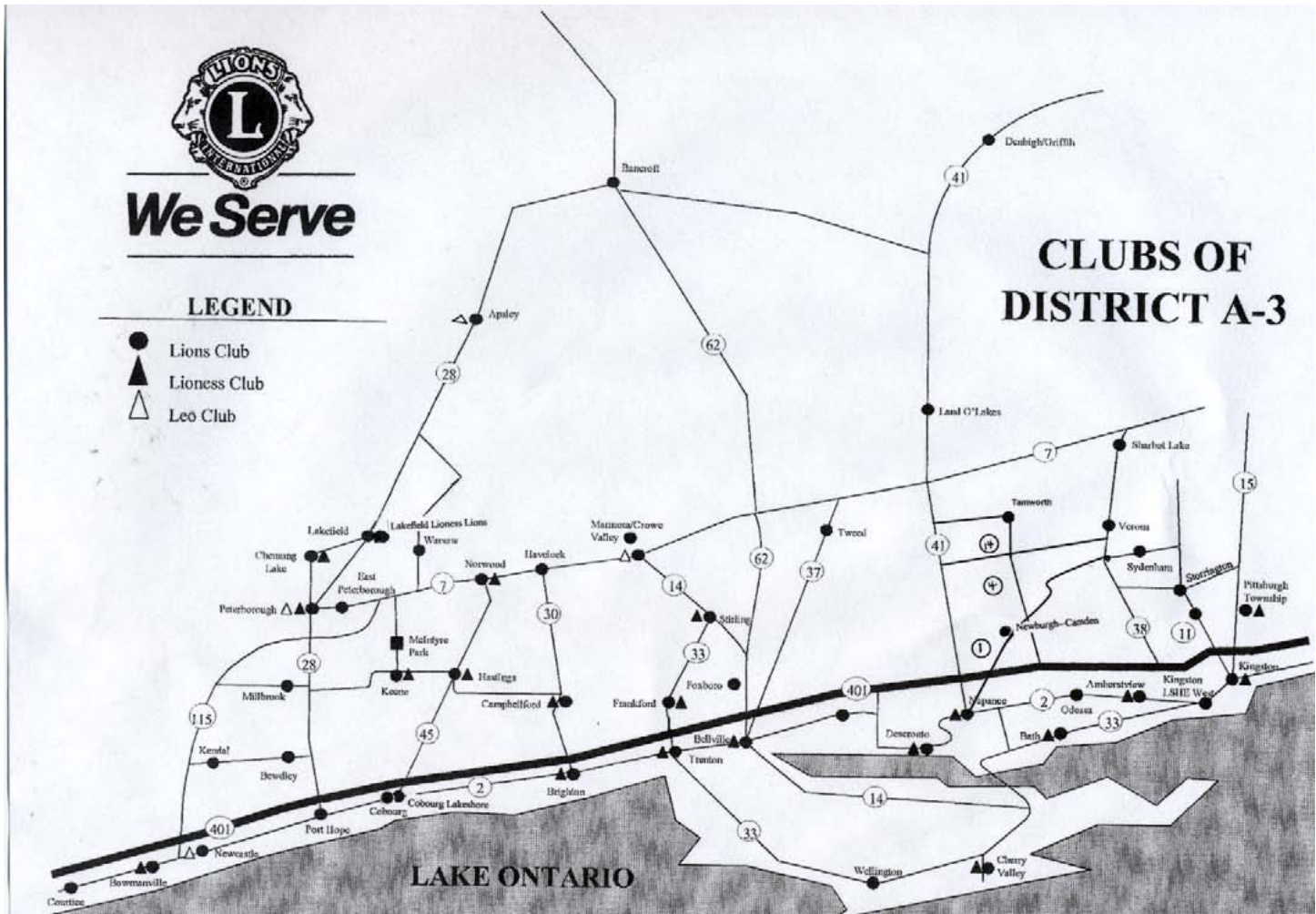

2. All twelve monthly M&A reports must be accounted for during the year.
3. M&A reports must be completed correctly and received by the District Governor by the 5th of the following month.
4. Form PU-101 with the names, addresses, telephone numbers, etc., of the newly-elected President, Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Chair must be properly completed and received by the International Office by May 26.
5. The Secretary must have attended, in person, at least 2 Zone Advisory Meetings of the Club's Zone.
6. The Secretary must have attended either the District A-3 or MD "A" Convention, or alternatively, the School for Incoming Club Officers, during the term of office.
7. Names of the incoming Club President, 1st. Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Chair and Bulletin Editor must be mailed to the District Governor Elect as soon as possible after the club elections.

DISTRICT A-3 VISITATION CONTEST (If Awarded)

Contest Rules:

1. The Purpose of the Contest is to promote a spirit of Inter-Club harmony and to see how other Clubs function.
2. Contest period – September 1st. to March 31st. inclusive.
3. Visitation Reports to be E-Mailed or sent to the Visitation Chairman by the 10th of the following month.
4. If repeated visits to the same club are made ... only the single best visit score will be allowed.
5. A minimum of 2 Lions must be on each visitation.
6. All visits must be made in District A-3 or adjoining Districts to A3.
7. Visits to adjoining Districts will receive member points up to 200 total Kms round trip from their home club.
8. Trips within District A-3 will be allowed to their total round trip Kms, measured from their home club.
9. Recognized Lions functions or activities are: Zone Meetings, Region Rallies, Charter Nights, Lions International Nights, District Conferences, Sports or Social events sponsored by Lions Clubs
10. No member of Cabinet or Lion campaigning for Office is eligible to win the Visitation Contest.
11. Contest will be in two (2) Categories:
 - (A) Clubs with 25 or fewer members.
 - (B) Clubs with 26 or more members.
12. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - One (1) point per member per Km traveled from home club.
 - Deduct 25% of member points if visit is made with any District Officer or International Officer on his Official visit.
13. Bonus points 100 points total if a full 10% of active membership are on the same visit. **OR**
 - 200 bonus points when a full 25% of the active membership is on the same visit. **OR**
 - 500 bonus points when full 50% of the active membership is on the same visit.
14. The names of the winning Clubs and the Lion who traveled the most Kms will be announced at the District A-3 Convention in April of each year.
